	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Macadamia Nuts - Experts have yet to determine why just a few of these nuts can produce tremors, even temporary paralysis, in a dogs hind legs.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Garlic - Garlic breaks down a dogs red blood cells, leading to anemia and possible kidney failure from leaking hemoglobin.
